SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE TIPS

Keeping warm adds to your safety and comfort. The hands are one of the hardest things to keep warm. A couple of suggestions are the next time you're in the market for gloves try either mittens or a pair of diver's gloves. The idea behind the mittens is that your fingers are all in contact with each other and therefore the surface area exposed to the air passing around the mittens is minimized. The diver's gloves are designed to keep the hands warm in frigid water because of the material they are made from and therefore work very well in cold weather. Remember to check your tires every two week if wether you ride a lot or not. Tires are not air tight regardless of design (tube or tubeless) and leak. Checking tire pressure will increase gas mileage, help prevent punctures and maintains proper handling of your bike.
